Wendy stated the funding will likely be CDBG or another grant-type funding source since it is costly. Chairperson Becker asked if the Madera Police Department can do routine handicap enforcement and report back quarterly statistics. Councilmember Smith stated that he will speak with Lieutenant Foss regarding that.
